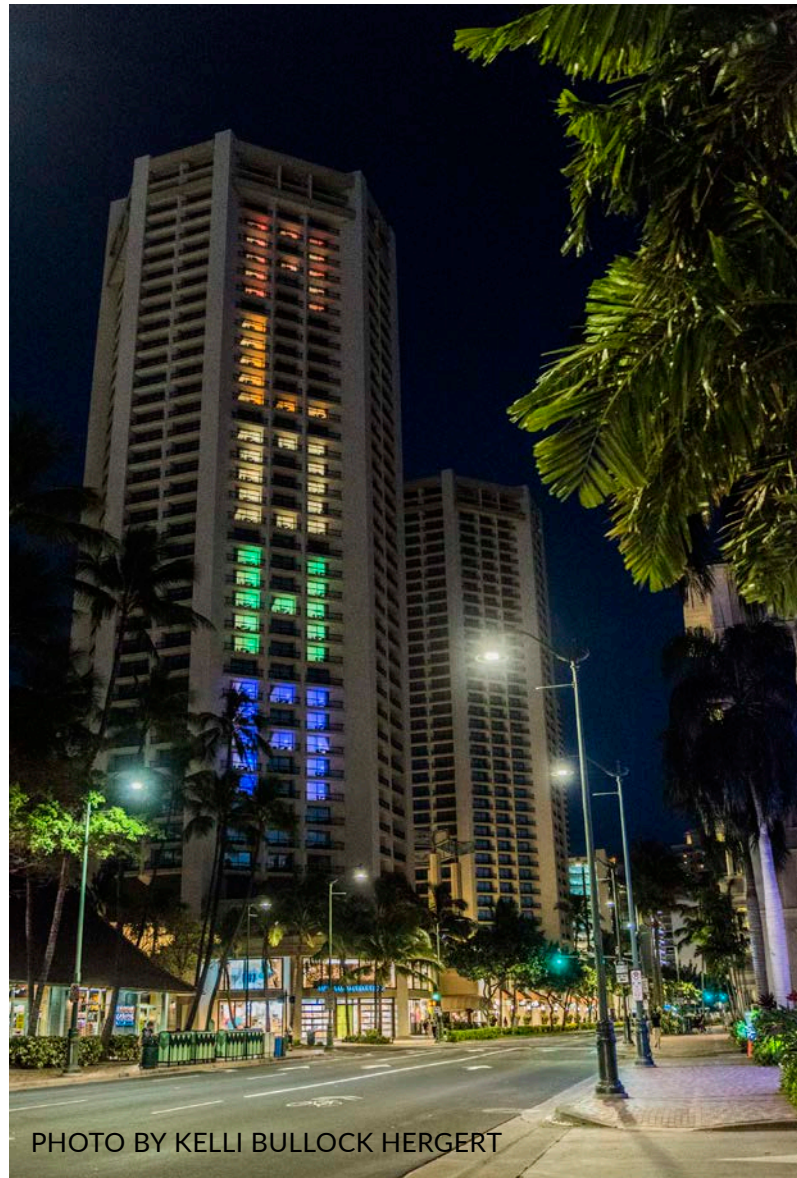

# Centennial Park Waikiki

**CONSTRUCTION IS UNDERWAY! THE TREES ARE COMING!**

---

The Hawaiian Dredging Company and its subcontractors started construction on March 9, 2020, for the long-awaited Centennial Park in Waikīkī. Grading of the site has begun, with archeological monitoring in place as well as input from Hawaiian cultural descendants.

Phase 1, including trees, grass and pathways, is expected to be completed by the end of May. “The City purchased the Centennial Park land back in 2003 for \$2.7 million and Rotary Club members, supporting individuals and organizations, raised funds for the construction of Phase 1 of the park,” said Rob Hale, chairman of the Centennial Park Committee.



Last year, in July 2019, the City and County of Honolulu, along with members of the Honolulu Rotary Club and Rotary District 5000 held a formal blessing and groundbreaking ceremony for Centennial Park in Waikiki.

Often referred to as the “green oasis” in Waikiki, the twenty-two-year long vision is finally taking shape! The only remaining patch of under-developed land in central Waikiki will

be transformed from a barren debris-strewn gravel lot into a haven of shade trees, greenery, education, culture and family activities.

Located at the corner of Aloha Drive and Seaside Avenue in Waikiki, Centennial Park is made possible through a private-public partnership with the City and the Rotary Club of Honolulu. It has brought together more than 80 volunteers to help with planning and construction.

## CENTENNIAL PARK WAIKIKI CONT.



Fundraising is ongoing for the Phase 2 construction work that includes a rock wall, new lighting and a metal picket wrap-around fence with gates to replace the existing chain link fence.

The overall plan includes Hawaiian Electric's switch vault and a proposed tour bus staging area next to the park along Manukai Street managed by the Waikīkī Transportation Management Association.



Hawaiian Electric will be installing a fully enclosed switch vault that will help to provide power to the lighting of the park as well as critical electric reliability capabilities for dozens of neighboring commercial and residential businesses.

For three days this summer, work on underground cables will require Hawaiian Electric to close a lane and restrict street parking on Seaside Avenue.

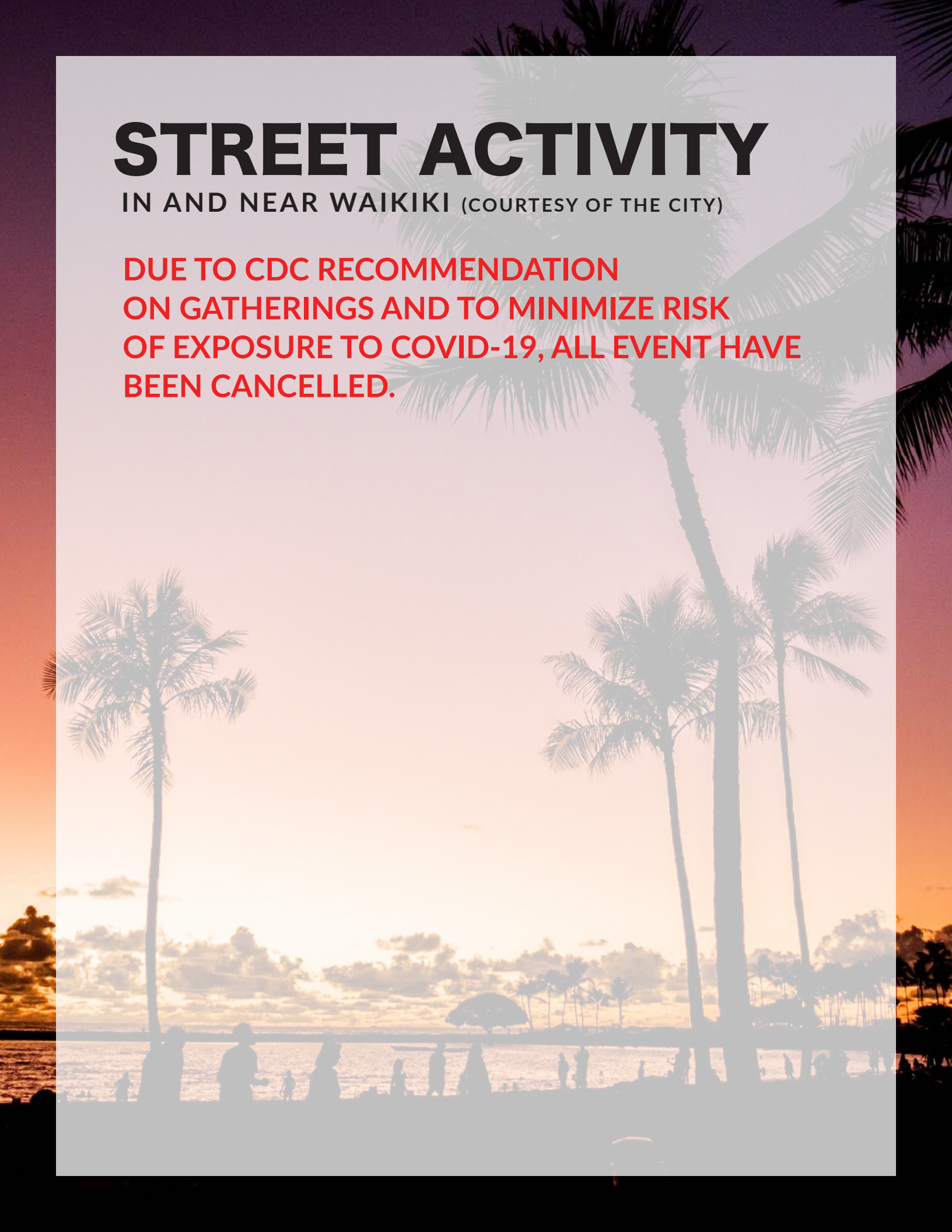

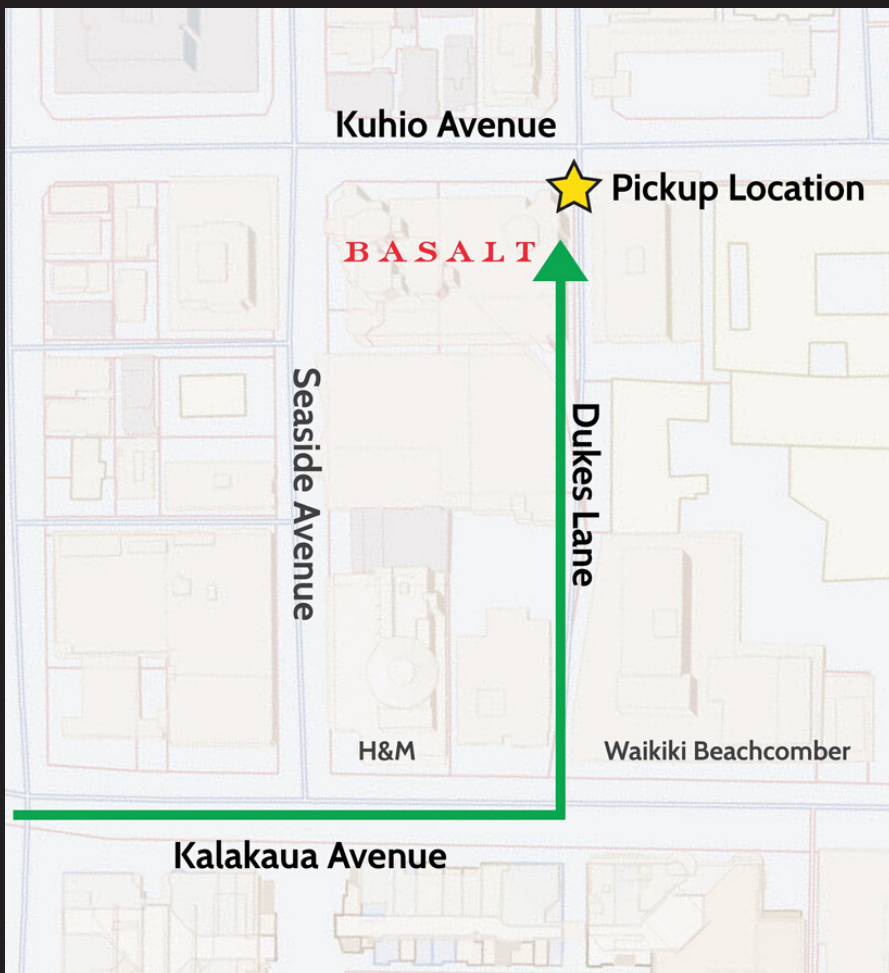
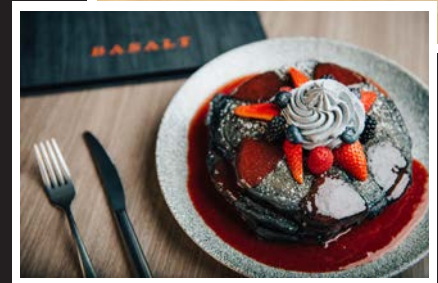

## CENTER CLOSES TO HELP PREVENT SPREAD OF COVID-19

On March 17, 2020, Gov. David Ige announced actions the State will be taking to support the worldwide efforts to mitigate and slow the spread of COVID-19. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Hawai'i Department of Health (DOH) have stressed the importance to expand social distancing and limit gatherings to no more than 10 people.

Under this guidance, the Hawai'i Convention Center closed for 30 days starting March 18, 2020, to ensure the health and safety of guests and staff due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Center is working closely with event and meeting planners who will be impacted to help with the rescheduling or cancellation of their event.

The Center will remain in close communication with local hospitality, state and government leaders to determine what additional measures need to be taken upon a planned reopening in mid-April.

The long-term sustainability of Hawai'i's visitor industry is vital to our economy. However, the safety and health of our residents, visitors and employees is our No. 1 priority. Our actions during this short moment in time will be critical to the long-term health of Hawai'i's people and our industry.
